- The Problem: If there was no problem, there would be no reason for writing a manuscript, and definitely no reason for reading it. So, please tell readers why they should proceed reading. Experience shows that for this part a few lines are often sufficient.
- The Proposed Solution: Now and only now! authors may outline the contribution of the manuscript. Here authors have to make sure readers point out what are the novel aspects of authors work. Authors should place the paper in proper context by citing relevant papers. At least, 5 references (recently journal articles) are used in this section.

2. Results and Discussion;

Results: Description of the results or findings in SEVERAL paragraphs; and Discussion: Extended discussion of the results--what they mean, what will or can happen next, what other experiments might be fruitful, etc.

- 3. Please ensure that: all references, tables, figures and equations have been cited in your text; Each citation should be written in the order of appearance in the text; The references must be presented in numbering and CITATION ORDER is SEQUENTIAL [1], [2], [3], [4], The references must be integrated also with not less than three (3) papers published on IAES's Journals.
